

**David Karmol** is currently a consultant to the International Code Council dealing with Federal regulatory affairs. He previously was Vice President for Federal Affairs, with responsibility for managing the Council's relationships with Congress, Federal agencies and outside organizations. He helped draft provisions of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 that relate to energy efficiency and building codes. Prior to joining the Code Council, Mr. Karmol was the U.S. Department of Commerce Standards Advisor to Iraq, stationed at U.S. Embassy Baghdad, detailed by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST).

He previously served as Vice President, Public Policy and Government Affairs at the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) and has been appointed to positions in the federal government, both in the Congress and in the Executive Branch. He was formerly an elected member of the Ohio State Legislature. Mr. Karmol is an attorney, licensed to practice law in Ohio, Virginia and the District of Columbia.
